Honestly, there were so many nights when we thought it was her last. She couldn't tolerate even a sip of water at times and all the food she passed had to be reintroduced into her body in a horrible procedure. It felt abusive and was difficult for her mama and the team to carry out. We cried out to the Lord on so many occasions pleading for Him to heal her.. and He did. We were able to connect with Dr Tecson and despite her not having reached the optimal weight for surgery, he said he would do it! She made a truly miraculous recovery and each day she continues to grow and thrive even more. We wanted her and her Mama to be able to stay together but as a single parent, her mom's difficulty was that if she got a job, there was no safe person in her life to mind K. She had grown up as an orphan herself and didn't have people to turn to. So, we decided to put action to our words that we support families and want to keep them together. We offered her Mama a job as a housekeeper at the Children's Home. This means she will be able to work during the day and bring K to work with her. Pray for them as they adjust and if you'd like to help sponsor K and her Mama, let us know! That would be life changing for them both.
