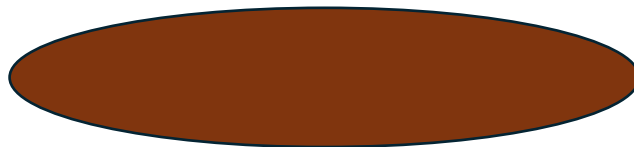

He holds a doctorate in Theology. He is not part of SBCC. He has a full ministry in Pasay City, where he started a church and Christian school. We partner in the training of pastors on both Luzon and Mindoro.

Timothy Mission also has a synergistic partnership with two ministries through our common involvement in disability ministry.

1. Just as TM partnered with a New Zealand based ministry to build a home for disabled children in San Rafael on the Main island of Luzon, we are partnering with Claire Goudy Henderson to establish an entire village of cottages for orphans so that they can live in a more natural home-like situation with a couple living in each cottage, overseeing their care. This also includes a Children's recovery unit for the medical care of seriously ill children and a cottage specifically for disabled children.

Pray for their safety; they live where radical Islamists regularly attack.
